Authorized agents

Nature and Type of Premises Licence

Directive No. 07.2020 is drafted based on the provisions of article 39(e) of the Betting Law of 2019 37(I)/2019, as amended or replaced from time to time, (hereinafter referred to as the “Law”), which concern the nature and the type of premises licence and stipulates that the premises licence authorizes the use of premises for the provision of Class A betting services and determines the plan of the premises.

2. Therefore, the National Betting Authority (hereinafter referred to as the “Authority”) has determined that the architectural plan of the premises must:

- a) display the floor plan of the said premises based on the specifications of the architectural plan (e.g. scales),
- b) be signed by a registered architect, and
- c) state the date of its preparation which should be three (3) months prior to the date of the application.

3. The Authority, based on article 42 of the Law, during the examination of the application for a premises licence, may reject the said application if the above conditions are not met and notifies the applicant accordingly, within a reasonable timeframe.

4. It is also clarified that, in case the Class A licenced bookmaker or the authorized agent intend to make any modification of the premises for which they have obtained a licence, they are obliged to submit a fully justified request to the Authority, for examination purposes.
