Directive 7/2016

Establishment of the Computerized System in the Republic by the Authority

Directive (No. 7/2016) is drawn up on the basis of the provisions of section 52(1)(c) of the Betting

Law ("Law") which concern the examination of an application for the approval by the Authority of a

computerised system and set out that the National Betting Authority ("Authority"), when examining

an application for the approval of a computerised system for the marking of bulletins or for the

amendment or replacement of an approved computerised system for the marking of bulletins, takes

into consideration whether the necessary equipment included, the electromechanical parts and

the software of the computerised system for the marking of bulletins, are and will remain

installed in the Republic.

2. As a consequence, the Authority gives Class A recipients a time frame of four (4) months in order

to transfer the equipment for the provision of betting services in the Republic. Thereafter, they must

inform the Authority of the location of the facilities.

3. Upon the expiry of the above mentioned period, the Authority shall carry out checks at the

facilities of Class A recipients, after a meeting is set in advance.

4. Provided that in the event of failure to comply with this Directive, the Authority may proceed with

suspending and/or revoking the Class A recipient license.
