

PUBLICATION PLAN

- This Publication Plan was prepared by the National Betting Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") pursuant to Article 7 of the Right of Access in the Public Sector Information Laws of 2017 and 2018 (L. 184 (I)/2017 as amended by L. 156 (I)/2018). The Publication Plan is in line with the Directive of the Office of the Commissioner for Personal Data Protection no. 03/2018, dated 04.09.2018.
- 2. The Authority was established in 2012 with the enactment of the Betting Law 106(I)/2012 which was replaced by the Betting Law of 2019 37(I)/2019 (hereinafter the "Law"). The Authority is composed of a seven-member Board of Directors, which consists of an Executive Chairman and six Members appointed by decision of the Council of Ministers.
